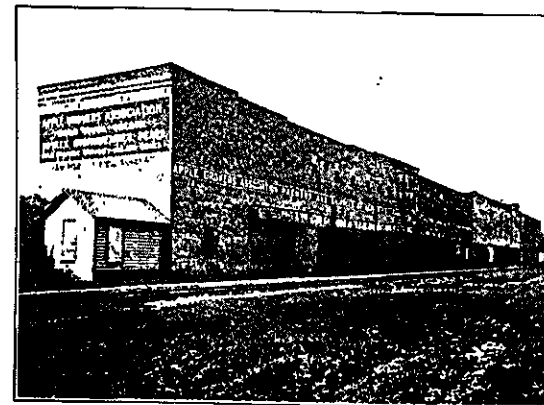

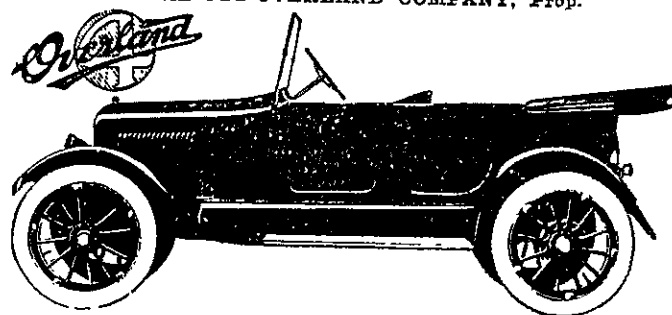

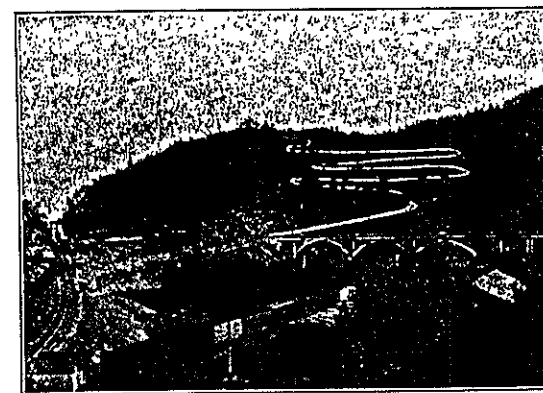

HOOD RIVER

Hood River County, Oregon, extends for 26 miles along the south bank of the Columbia River, and stretches for an equal distance to the southward, embracing within its boundaries the majestic snow-capped peak of Mt. Hood. The county seat is the town of Hood River, with a population of 3000, situated at the junction of the Hood River with the Columbia. The city is the business center of the county or valley, as it is aptly termed, and its business houses are first class in every respect. Two banks, with deposits of nearly two and one-half million dollars; two excellent hotels, two up-to-date newspapers, and all the various shops that are incidental to the life of the modern city, are represented. Six large garages take care of the needs of the 1000 automobiles owned in the community, and of the thousands of tourists that have found Hood River one of the charming spots of the Northwest.

The business streets of the city are paved with concrete and the residence streets with oil-bound macadam. Practically every sidewalk is of cement. The city owns its own water system, piped in seven miles from pure, gushing mountain springs, involving an investment of \$150,000.

The educational advantages to be found in the City of Hood River and throughout the valley are of the highest standard that a progressive citizenship can provide and are second to none in any rural community on the Pacific Coast.

Climate

The climate of Hood River as summed up by the United States Department of Agriculture in a soil survey of the valley reads as follows: "The

sixth in Spring, an inch or two in Summer, and nine inches in the Fall. Winter temperatures are not severe, and though the nightly temperature during January and February is usually from 22 to 32 degrees, it seldom falls below zero, that condition having happened but three times in thirteen years. The Summer is marked by relatively cool days and nights. The thermometer may rise to 90, possibly higher, but such extremes persist for about three days only, and are succeeded by periods of cooler weather when the maximum will reach 80. Irrigation takes the place of rain in Summer, and is a much more satisfactory condition for agriculture. The usual Spring conditions are such that there is little danger to the apple crops from late Spring frosts. Smudge pots are unheard of in Hood River Valley. The prevailing winds are from the west, and the Winters are practically without wind. The drift of the wind from the west is the factor that maintains a low Summer and a high Winter temperature."

Transportation

The Oregon-Washington Railway & Navigation Company, a part of the Union Pacific System, direct from Chicago, passes through Hood River on its way to Portland, and four passenger trains daily each way serve the traffic. Service is so arranged that travelers may leave Hood River at various times, from early morning to late in the afternoon.

The Columbia River is used by several boat lines, which land a half mile from the business district of the city. It is expected that in the next few years the river route will be used more extensively than at present.

The marvelous Columbia River Highway affords another great means of communication between Portland and Hood River, an automobile being able to easily make its sixty-eight miles of hard-surfaced pavement in two and one-half hours. Over this highway motor trucks will enter largely into the future transportation of the products of Hood River Valley, delivering direct from the Hood River orchard to the consumer in Portland.

In the matter of local transportation the Mount Hood Railroad connects the town of Hood River with Parkdale, its southern terminus, twenty-three miles away in the upper valley, with numerous stations dotting the line. The passenger traffic on this road is served with up-to-date motor rail cars running at frequent intervals.

Excellent roads are to be found in all parts of the valley and the county is now considering bonding for a system of hard-surfaced highways to take care of the rapidly increasing traffic. All bridge replacements are being built of concrete and it is the policy to make everything of a permanent nature.

Land

Of the 60,000 acres of tillable land, 23,000 are in cultivation and 37,000 as yet in an uncleared state. Many of these uncleared lands have been logged off by the lumber interests and a large portion lie in the upper valley adjacent to the big mills at Dec. Good uncleared land may be had as low as \$50 per acre and the cost of clearing will average, at the present high cost of labor, about \$150 per acre. Orchards in bearing are valued by their owners at \$1000 per acre, who maintain that this valuation will pay 10 per cent year in and year out. Upon the mountain sides and along the streams will be found thousands of accessible and picturesque building sites, which are now being much sought after by those who are desirous of Summer homes amidst the many and varied attractions that Hood River has to offer.

Products

The principle products are apples, pears, strawberries and cherries, the extreme high quality of which has made Hood River a household word throughout the world. Hood River is primarily a fruit country and all kinds of deciduous fruits attain perfection here. The most perfect and prolific D'Anjou pear trees known to the fruit industry are grown in this section.

At the Chicago World's Fair in 1893 and again at the Panama-Pacific Exposition in San Francisco in 1915, the Hood River strawberry outclassed the world, taking first prizes at both places. It was the Hood River cherries that

soil is particularly adapted to large yields of this most important article of food. Of late years corn has proven a most profitable crop in all sections of the valley; also alfalfa and clover.

Industries

Being a fruit country, the principal industry, therefore, is the raising and shipping of fruit. Along the tracks of the O.W. R. & N. Co. in the City of Hood River are a thousand linear feet of coldstorage warehouses, three stories high, with ice-making, cold storage and pre-cooling machinery, to properly care for the 600,000 boxes of fruit they will hold at one time while awaiting shipment. On the tracks of the Mount Hood Railway in the city are also several storage warehouses, so that the combined storage space will probably aggregate a million boxes. At Van Horn Station on the Mount Hood line another large cold storage plant of 125,000 box capacity is located. At Odell, and also at Parkdale on this line, are a number of warehouses belonging to various shipping concerns, so that the handling and storage of fruit is well taken care of throughout the valley.

In the City of Hood River is located one of the largest cider and vinegar plants west of the Mississippi River, the annual capacity of which is 2,000,000 gallons; an excellent cannery, whose products are much sought after by buyers of extra high quality goods; a large spray factory, which ships its output to all parts of the Pacific Coast; an up-to-date flour mill; a co-operative creamery, which handles the cream from the ranches, and a good-sized packing plant which turns the pigs into bacon and ham.

The lumber industry ranks next to that of fruit, the lumber shipments from the county amounting to about \$750,000 annually. There are two large plants, one at Dee on the Mount Hood Railway, and the other at Cascade Locks, the extreme western edge of the county; also several smaller ones scattered around in the surrounding forests.

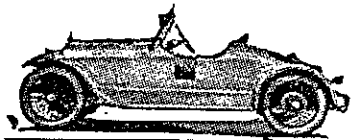
